

Quality and affordable Canadian education

STUDENT often wonder which pathways are the best to achieve success in the future. One of the most well-known countries that Malaysian students would consider to pursue their studies is Canada.

Established in 1991, Bronte College is a private co-educational boarding school that offers secondary school education from grade 9 to grade 12 (equivalent to Form 3 to 6).

Upon completion of Grade 12, graduates receive the Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD), which is widely recognized around the world.

Bronte is also one of the few colleges in Canada that is known as Advanced Placement (AP) school. Students could choose to sit for AP exams and earn credits for their university years. Students wishing to prepare for AP exams are given 40 hours extra tutorial at no extra cost.

There’s no reason to fall behind at Bronte. Classes are maintained on average of 15 students per class for better student attention. Bronte College’s tuition fee is comparable to most private colleges and many find it hard to believe that Bronte’s tuition fees only ranges between RM35,000 and RM40,000 per year.

Another great advantage to Bronte’s academic system is that students may enter in any one of the three semesters, Sept, Feb or July. Exceptional candidates may also qualify for scholarships.

The upcoming intakes for Bronte are September 2013 and January 2014.

If you are now preparing to sit for your SPM in November/December, the most suitable intake will be January 2014.

Bronte accepts forecast and trial exam results issued by reputable secondary schools in Malaysia.

Students will also be required to sit for an entrance test before the College could officially enroll you.
